



CASARA/PEP(Air) is recruiting a search pilot for the Nanaimo area

PILOT QUALIFICATIONS

- Minimum 19 years of age.
- Valid pilot license and medical.
- Minimum 250 hrs PIC.
- Required enrolment in the Provincial Emergency Program (Air) and the Mid-Island Air SAR Association.
- Ready access to a high-wing, four-place aircraft. Preference is for non-rented aircraft with engine power equal to or greater than 200 HP.

PERSONAL QUALIFICATIONS

The successful applicant will be a team-player with an interest in search and rescue. He or she must undertake certification training as a search pilot and maintain certification by attending meetings and training exercises.

The successful applicant must coordinate with three other search pilots to ensure availability of a search aircraft for operational searches.

ADDITIONAL INFORMATION

Aircraft flying costs are reimbursed at a calculated rate using aircraft horsepower and fuel pricing.

Training meetings are held monthly at the CASARA Search Headquarters located in the Nanaimo Flying Club Hangar.
