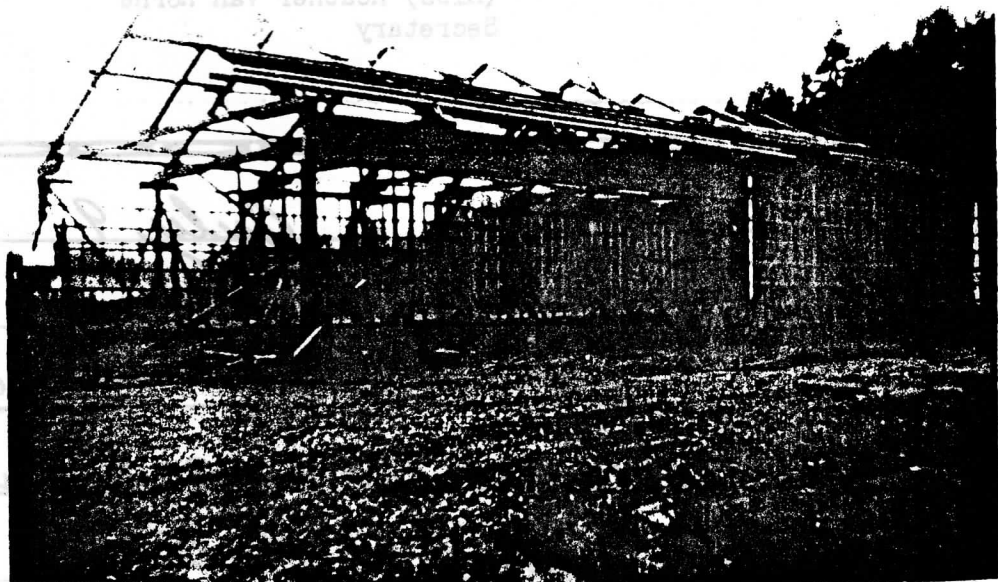

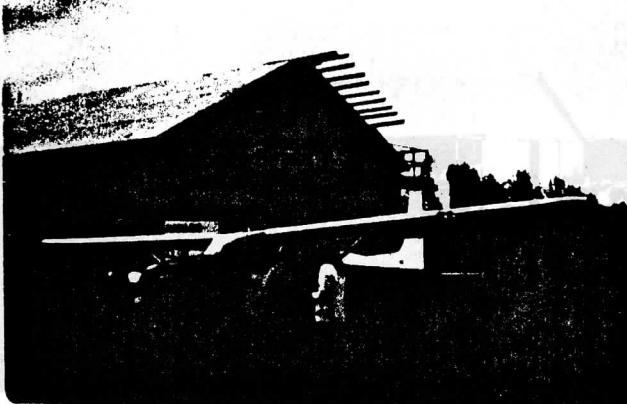

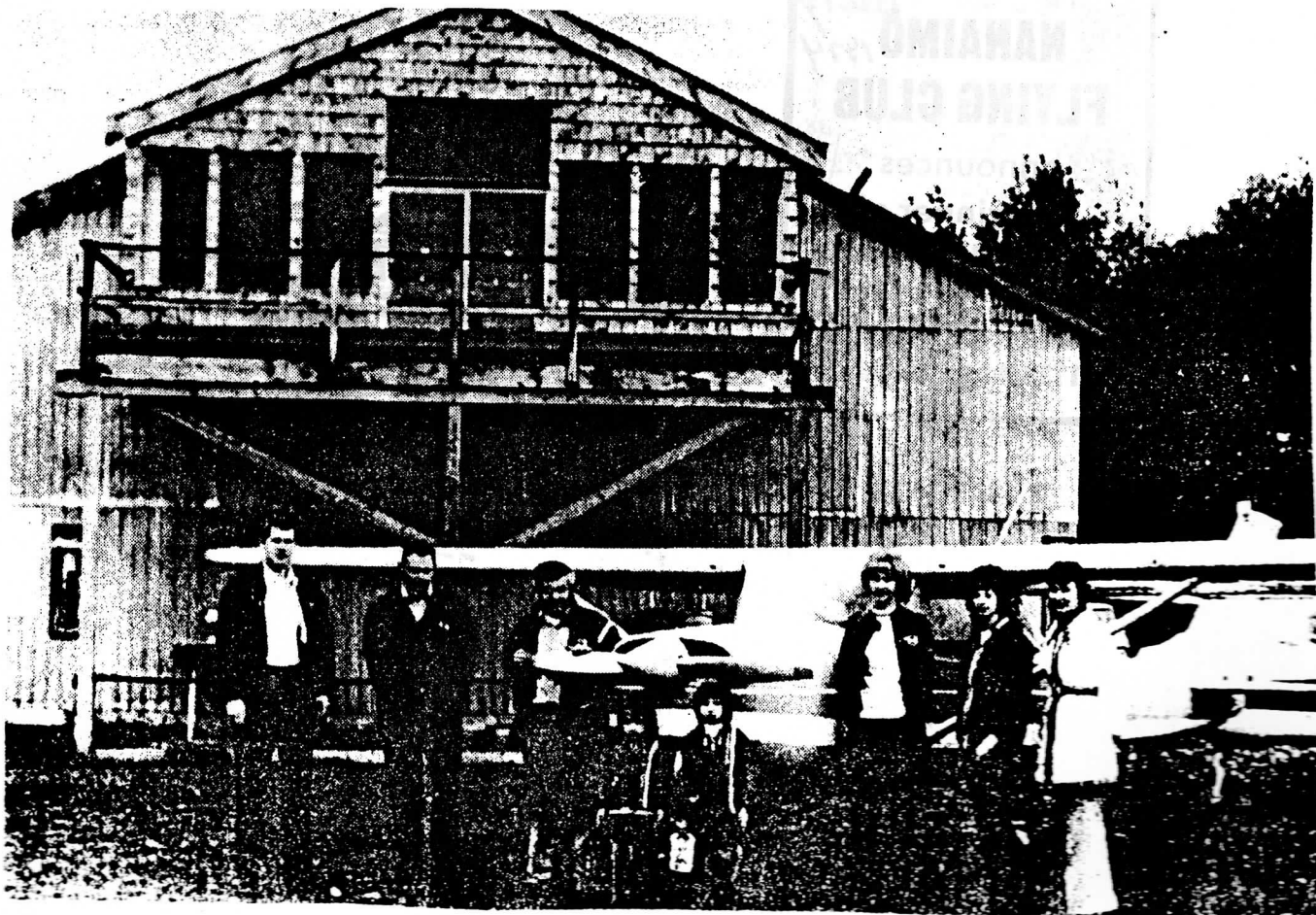
HANGAR, early 1970

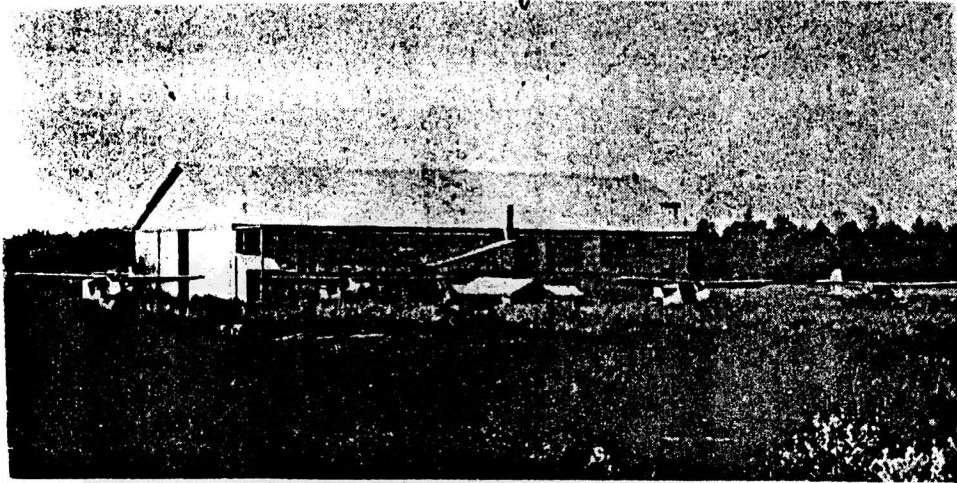

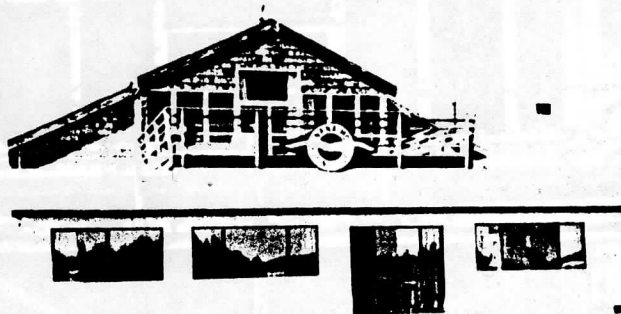

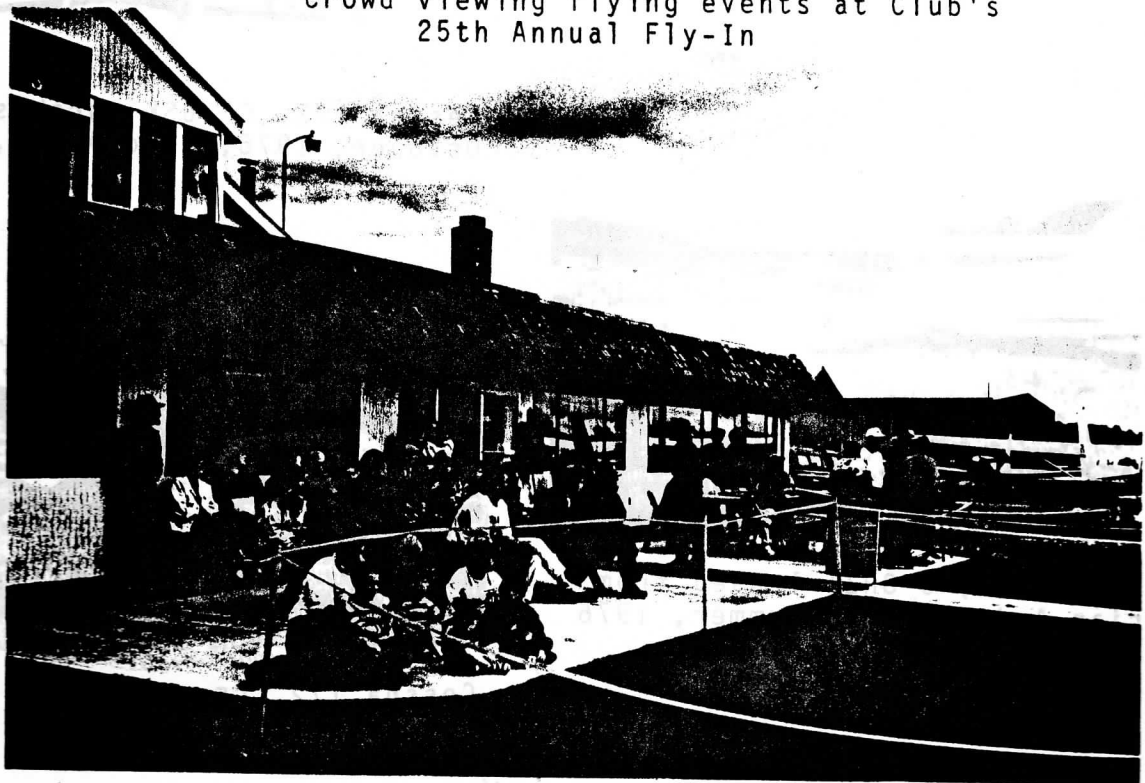

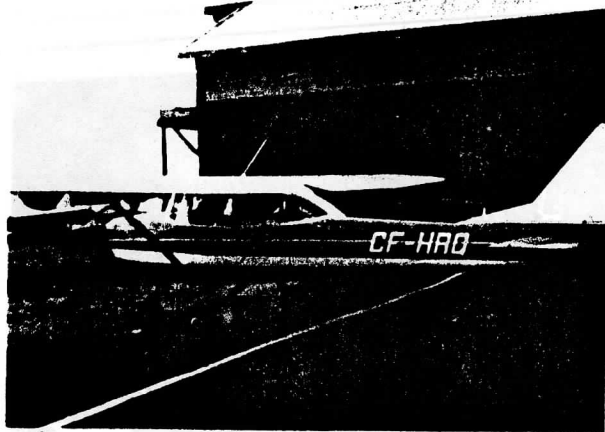

Cessna 172, C-GHZI leased from Brian Andrews from Summer, 1976 to May, 1979.

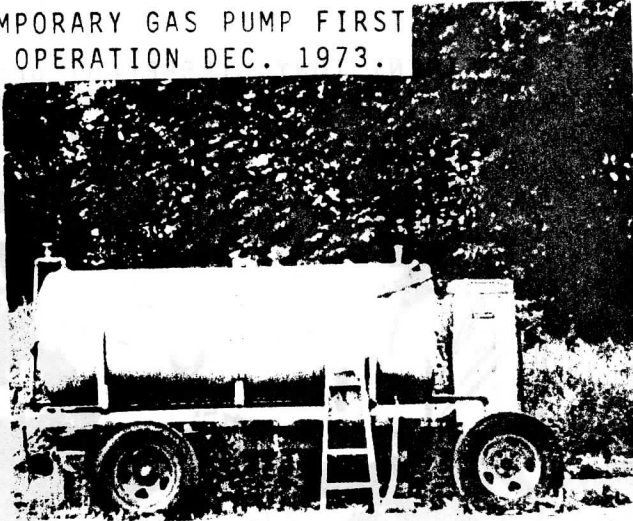

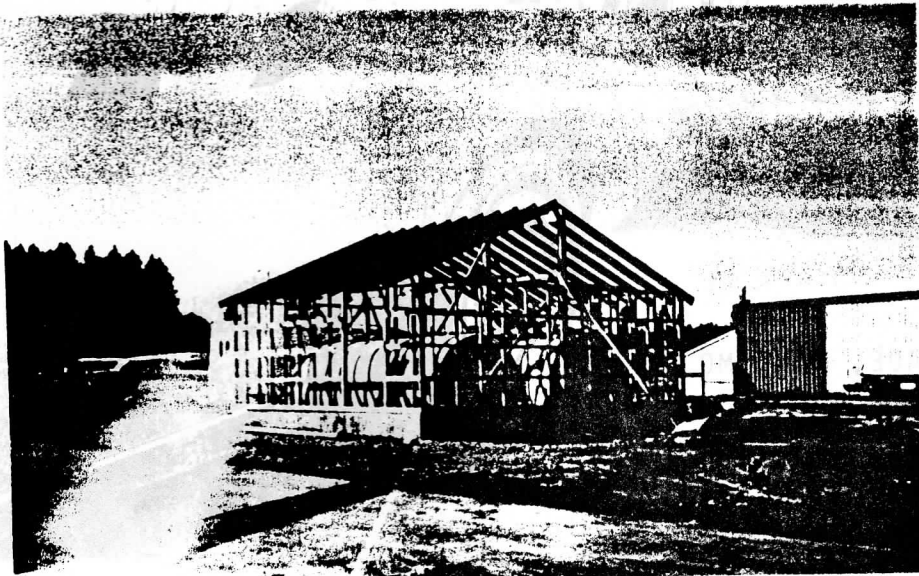
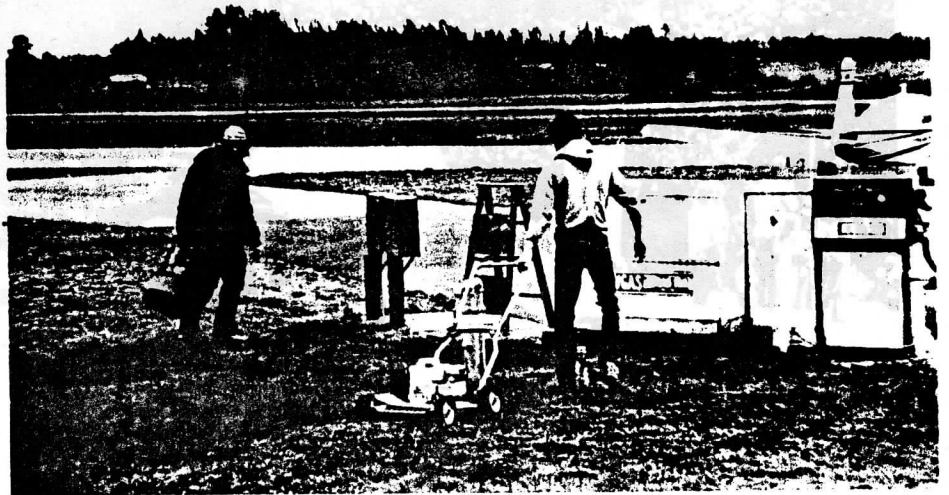
TEMPORARY GAS PUMP FIRST

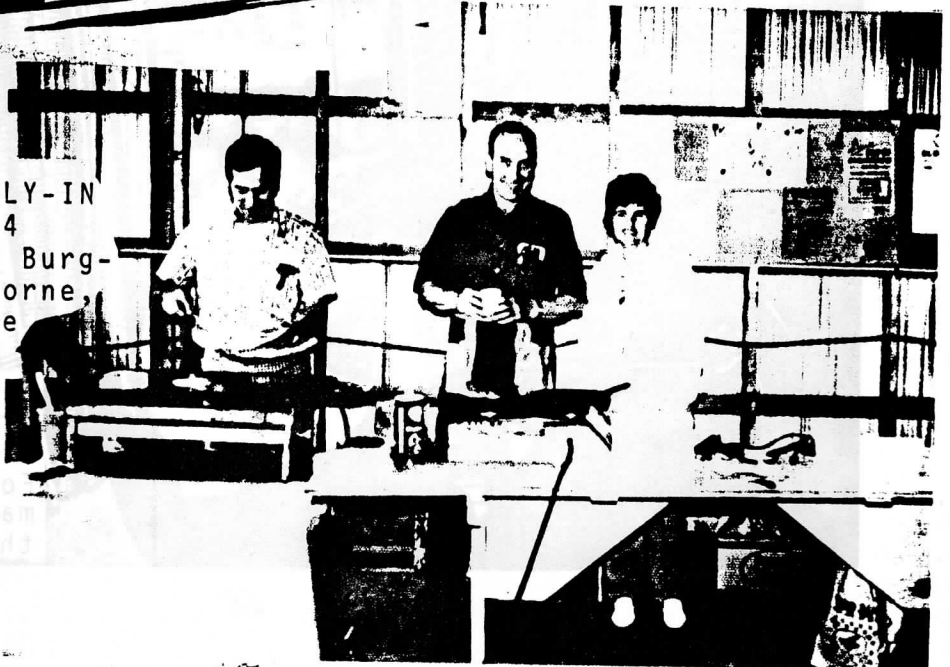
